I.S.A. ELITE Series Conditions:

***** All owners of nominated horse(s) must be PAID ISA Members by May 15, 2009**

- All owners must be PAID ISA Members at the time of the race
- All races will be one dash at one mile
- Horses may transfer gaits, with monies to follow
- All events will be governed by the rules of the USTA and IHRC
- No horse may compete in the ELITE Series who has raced in any other race on the day of, or any two (2) days prior to the event (qualifiers and rained-out ISFC events excluded)
- Horses must have participated in (or credited with) at least five (5) Indiana Sired Fair Circuit races in order to participate in an Elite race.
- If more than nine (9) entries are received, races will be contested in divisions
- All horses nominated must be Indiana Sired
- Regardless of the number of horses entered, the races will be contested.
- The ISA reserves the right to reject any questionable nomination.
- ISA Board of Directors will have the final decision in any dispute.
