

The ISA Scholarship Program



2010 - 2011 Scholarship Requirements

The following are requirements for submitting a scholarship application:

- Ω Applicant / parent / guardian / or grandparent must be a **2010 ISA Member**
- Ω Applicant must be an **Indiana resident by April 30, 2010**
- Ω Applicant may be pursuing any course of study but must be **working towards a 2-year associate's, a 4-year bachelor's degree, or a technical trade school.**
- Ω Applicant must be **enrolled as a full time student** (at least 12 credit hours)
- Ω Applicant must be at least a **high school senior.**
- Ω Applicant must have a **3.0 GPA or higher**
- Ω Applicant may **reapply each year** but must request an application on an annual basis

The following items must be returned to the I.S.A. Office to be eligible for the scholarship:

- _____ Completed ISA Scholarship Application
- _____ Copy of Transcript (H.S. or College Trans)
- _____ Copy of the first page of your parents/guardians most recent IRS Tax return
- _____ Copy of the first page of the most recent Indiana State Tax return (to verify Indiana Residency)
- _____ Letter of recommendation from a high school teacher or college professor
- _____ Letter of recommendation from Standardbred affiliate (other than immediate family)
- _____ Typewritten essay on subject to be determined by committee
- _____ Resume (optional)

Applications will be evaluated by a designated scholarship committee. All applicants will be judged on academic achievement and financial need.

A complete application and all the required attachments must be postmarked by June 15, 2010 for application to be considered.
