

Licensing Information:

The State of Indiana has two licensing offices for your convenience. You may our call Hoosier Park office at (765) 609-4588 or our Indiana Downs office at (317) 713-3350.

Applications may be obtained from either licensing office. When applying for a license you may call our office to have us fax or mail you an application for your convenience. However, you may need to come in the office to finish out the licensing process. License fees vary.

All applicants must be printed in the State of Indiana every five (5) years. Using our fingerprint card is suggested because it gives you an option of choosing more States for the FBI print response to be sent to at no extra charge (hopefully cutting down on the number of times you need to be printed); however, any card obtained may be used. If you would like us to mail you a card, simply call one of the numbers above. The charge for fingerprint processing is \$36.00, we fingerprint for free at the licensing offices.

Indiana issues photo ID badges to applicants licensed. You will get a new picture when you are licensed for the new race year. This allows you on the grounds and the paddock with your horse. If you lose you badge it will be a \$10.00 charge for a new one.

MOST FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS

When do I need to be licensed?

You must be licensed before your horse races/qualifies or before the Licensing office closes for the day, if you are racing in a late race.

When is the Licensing office open?

Hoosier Park licensing office will be open Tuesday – Friday 1pm- 5:30pm, Saturday 10am- 2pm, closed Sunday and Monday.

Indiana Downs will be open Monday – Friday 9 am – 3 pm, closed Saturday and Sunday until April 6th. Please call for future office hours.

To contact the licensing office you may call 317/713-3350.

Can I get licensed at either Track?

Yes. The licensing offices are the same agency, just in two different locations. So, you may go to either location for licensure. Also, if you are licensed at one track you are okay to race at the other one for the same race year.
