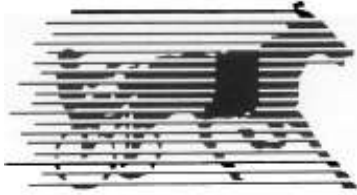

ISA SCHOLARSHIP APPLICATIONS DUE MAY 15, 2006

The non-renewal scholarship is for one full time student (12 credit hours) @\$1,200 for the upcoming school year or for two part-time students (6 credit hours) @ \$600 each for the upcoming school year. Deadline for receiving applications is May 15, 2006.

The following criteria is the basis for selection of students for the award:

- Indiana residency as of May 1, 2006
- Parent and/or applicant must be current paid ISA member as of May 1, 2006
- Maintain a 2.0 GPA or higher
- High school graduate thru 21 years of age as of start of the upcoming school year
- Enrolled in at least six credit hours for the upcoming year

2006 ISA MEMBERSHIP IS DUE - \$25

To be eligible for sulky and jog cart I.S.A. insurance benefits the driver, the trainer and all owners or lessees of the hooked horse must ALL be "Paid I.S.A. Members 2006" before the accident and damage to sulky or jog cart occurs.

Maximum limit has been increased to \$1,250 for any race bike or jog cart damaged and eligible for ISA insurance.
